MOBILE VETERAN OUTREACH — Reaching the “Unreachable”

Mobile Veteran Outreach (MVO) delivers one-on-one personalized outreach and engagement activities directly to the locations where our at-risk veterans live.

A formerly homeless veteran (now university-certified in psychology/substance abuse disorders) leads the MVO outreach team. Having “lived the life,” he has a unique ability to reach and engage veterans into services, or assess their needs. He and his service dog, Leo, drive directly to homeless encampments, gathering spots, tents, freeway overpasses and alleys to directly engage veterans regarding their earned benefits and a range of services to change their trajectory from negative to positive.
