Gold Coast Veterans Foundation, The Ronald Reagan Presidential Foundation Receive Support

SIMI VALLEY, CALIF. (November 17, 2022) — Logix Federal Credit Union announced today the conclusion of its latest Paying with a Purpose: Salute to Veterans Campaign, having raised \$60,000 to benefit three local nonprofits.

From August 8 to November 8, each time a member used their Logix Mastercard© credit or debit card, Logix made a donation of two cents to support the Ronald Reagan Presidential Foundation and Institute in Simi Valley, Gold Coast Veterans in Camarillo and Homes 4 Families in Woodland Hills.

"Members embraced our Paying with a Purpose campaign; this year, we recognized our veterans," said Melia Keller, Vice President of Marketing and Community Relations at Logix. "Two cents adds up, and these dollars will be used to support veterans – our heroes who serve our country. Ensuring our military personnel are taken care of when they return home is important. Keller championed the effort, as she served in the U.S. Army Reserve from 2000 to 2008. She was acknowledged at the Veterans Commemoration on November 11 at the Reagan Library.

On November 5, Gold Coast Veterans Foundation hosted a luncheon for volunteers and donors at their facility in Camarillo. Executive Director Bob Harris spoke at the event, and shared his gratitude for the contribution.
